For Christians, the Advent season anticipates Christmas, the celebration of God coming to earth to live among us in the person of Jesus Christ. Six centuries before that Bethlehem miracle, the prophet Isaiah wrote, "The people walking in darkness have seen a great light; on those living in the land of the shadow of death, a light has dawned" (Isaiah 9:2, NIV).


Joy is a rare commodity for many people who haven't been awakened to new life in Christ. "As the Father has loved Me, so have I loved you. Now remain in My love. ... I have told you this so that My joy may be in you" (John 15:9, 11; NIV). Pray with us that this Advent, the joy of Jesus will be the evidence of his salvation transformation in the lives of thousands of people around the world.

Last Sunday we lit the first two candles, one for hope and one for peace. Today we light the third candle, the candle of joy. This should be the easy one, because joy is all around us—in the children, the lights, the music, the gathering

together. But how often do we let our preparations—or our memories—push joy to the side? Joy is like an underground spring that wells up within us, but joy is also a choice, an attitude. Like a muscle, it needs to be exercised. So today we open ourselves to joy, trusting that God has already planted it in us. All we need to do is give it care and offer it to share.
